Overview

The U.S. Department of Labor Veteran's Employment and Training Services (VETS) is focused on the military to civilian transition process; strategic partnerships are a critical component of increasing veteran employment opportunities. The HIRE Vets Medallion Award is an award given annually that recognizes employers committed to recruiting, employing and retaining veterans. This partner communications toolkit serves as resource for the HIRE Vets Medallion Program to collaborate with federal and local government agencies, nonprofit organizations, and private sector partners to promote the prestigious HIRE Vets Medallion Award. This toolkit offers general information about the HIRE Vets Medallion Award, as well as examples for how this information may be used in collaboration with partner organizations' messaging and outreach. By assisting the Department of Labor in reaching out to businesses and organizations within the partners' networks, partners can help amplify the importance of the HIRE Vets Medallion Award, increase engagement with employers, and ultimately improve veteran career opportunities.



HIRE Vets Medallion Program Frequently Asked Questions

WHAT IS THE HIRE VETS MEDALLION AWARD?

The HIRE Vets Medallion Award recognizes employers who are committed to hiring and retaining veterans in meaningful, long-term careers. Veterans benefit from career growth, and employers gain dedicated employees who make significant contributions with continued service in business.

WHY PARTICIPATE?

The HIRE Vets Medallion Award is the only federal award of its kind, recognizing an organization's dedication to hiring and retaining veterans in meaningful, long-term careers. The medallion is the highest federal standard for businesses of all sizes and geographic locations.

HOW DO I GET INVOLVED?

Visit <u>HIREVets.gov</u> to learn about the application process, sign up for our newsletter, and learn how your business can meet the criteria for this honor. The HIRE Vets Medallion Award application period opens on January 31. Now is the time to ensure employers are aware of the opportunity to earn recognition before the 2021 application period closes on April 30.

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

The Honoring Investments in Recruiting and Employing American Military Veterans Act of 2017 directed a program to recognize employers of all sizes for their investment efforts to recruit, employ, and retain our nation's veterans. An award application fee is required to cover the cost of administering the program so that there will be no cost to the taxpayer. The award criteria are set in the Code of Federal Regulations and applicants can determine if they qualify before they submit.

Your dedication to employing our veterans demonstrates a commitment to honoring service, economic development, and inclusion in the workplace. Organizations earning the HIRE Vets Medallion Award are recognized by the Department of Labor and can market their medallion award to attract talent and inform customers. Upon notification of the award, you will receive a certificate in the mail, as well as digital assets to use in multimedia platforms. We offer press kits, event invitations, and continued support for local promotions.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

The HIRE Vets Medallion Award is an annual process, and any business can apply, regardless of previous award submissions. Please see our schedule and requirement criteria. Your business can determine eligibility before submitting a nomination.

US Department of Labor accepting 2021 HIRE Vets Medallion Award applications

WASHINGTON, DC – The U.S. Department of Labor announced today that its <u>Veterans'</u> <u>Employment and Training Service</u> is accepting applications for the 2021 HIRE Vets Medallion Award, presented annually to employers that meet standards for excellence in the recruitment, hiring and retention of America's military veterans.

Initiated by the Honoring Investments in Recruiting and Employing American Military Veterans Act of 2017 and administered by VETS, the award recognizes small businesses, non-profit organizations and large companies for leadership in promoting veterans' employment. The open application period marks the beginning of the 2021 HIRE Vets Medallion Award cycle. Employers that receive the award in 2021 will join more than 1,000 employers that the department has recognized for their support of America's veterans.

"America's veterans put their exceptional training, skills and experience to work for employers throughout the nation," said Acting Assistant Secretary of Labor for Veterans' Employment and Training James Rodriguez. "The HIRE Vets Medallion Award recognizes employers – of all sizes across many industries – for helping these uniquely qualified workers become valued contributors to our nation's workforce and economy."

To complete the application process, employers must verify that their organization meets award requirements, pay the application fee and comply with the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights and the Vietnam Era Veterans' Readjustment acts. Employers must apply by April 30, 2021.

These business leaders know from experience that veterans often bring the following attributes and characteristics to the workplace: proven leadership, mission focused approach to work, technical skills, strong work ethic, and many other strengths.

The U.S. Department of Labor's HIRE Vets Medallion Program recognizes employers of all sizes for their efforts to recruit, employ, and retain America's veterans. The HIRE Vets Medallion Award is earned by leading employers across three different size categories – small (1-50 employees), medium (51-499), and large (500 or more). Award recipients range from small businesses and community-based nonprofits to larger companies.

The medallion selection includes rigorous criteria that demonstrate an employers' long-term commitment to veteran employment.

Veteran Employment Quick Facts


- In 2020, 18.5 million men and women were veterans, accounting for about 7 percent of the civilian population age 18 and over. Of all veterans, 1 in 10 were women.
- Approximately 48% of the veteran population is in the workforce, nearly 9 million workers, which is less than 6% of the total workforce.
- Each year there are nearly 200,000 service members transitioning from the military to the civilian workforce.
- Within the military there are over 1100 career specialties.
- Veterans often bring the following attributes and characteristics to the workplace: proven leadership, mission focused approach to work, technical skills, strong work ethic, and many other strengths.
- Only 28% of high school seniors can qualify for military service.
- American Job Centers give businesses access to resources they need to recruit, train, and retain a skilled Veteran workforce. They may also be known as "Career One-Stops" or "Career Centers" depending on the state.
